OPERATION KUKHRI

Operation KUKHRI

- ✦ A unique multinational operation launched in United Nations Assistance Mission in Sierra Leone (UNAMSIL)
- ✦ Aim of operation was to break 2 months long siege laid by armed cadres of the revolutionary United Front (RUF) around 2 companies of Gorkha Rifles Infantry Battalion group.
- ✦ Marshal people of Nepal are called Gorkha.
- ✦ 1817; Anglo-Nepal war; Gorkha Kingdom was divided into Dehradun, Garhwal, Kumaon, Nepal, Sikkim, Morung.
- ✦ Gorkha are the soldiers of Nepalese nationality recruited in the :-
 1. British army
 2. Nepalese Army
 3. Indian Army
 4. Gorkha Contingent Singapore
 5. Gorkha Reserve Unit Brunei
 6. UN Peace Keeping force

- ✦ This operation was performed in Sierra Leone (Free Town) Capital
- ✦ From 1991 to 2002, Sierra Leone was engulfed in civil war which devastated the country
- ✦ The war was characterized by extreme brutality & widespread human rights abuses against civilians
- ✦ It left more than 50,000 people dead, much of the country's infrastructure destroyed & over 2 million Sierra Leoneans displaced as refugees in neighbouring countries.
- ✦ In October 1999, UN agreed to send peacekeepers to help restore order & disarm the rebels
- ✦ Daru & Kailahun
- ✦ By mid-April of 2000, two of the companies of INDBATT-1 were deployed in Kailahun, while the rest were deployed in Daru.
- ✦ However the situation at Kailahun kept deteriorating and the 2 companies of 5/8th Gorkha Rifles remained in their base surrounded by hundreds of RUF rebels of the 1st Brigade.

The rescue plan had 5 phases:

- (1) Mobilisation of UNAMSIL forces.
 - (2) Pre-emptive strike by helicopter & breakout by the besieged forces at Kailahun,
 - (3) Link up of besieged Kailahun column & special forces unit,
 - (4) Link up of Daru column & Kailahun column at Pendembu.
 - (5) All forces fall back to Daru
- ✦ Ground Units & Airborne Units-
 1. 223 troops of 5/8th Gorkha Rifles.
 2. 1 QRF of Mechanical Infantry & Para commandos
 3. 18th grenadiers
 4. 2 Para (SF)
 5. QRC of Mechanical Infantry
 6. 1 Company of Engineers
 - ✦ Air support
